Terms Of Service and End User License Agreement Songbooks Online

This is a legal agreement between you and Karaokeware Inc. as provider of the Songbooks Online subscription service, including any and /all other authorized agents in reference to this agreement ("Providers"), stating the terms that govern your use of the Songbooks Online service (Service). This agreement – together with all updates, additional terms, software, licenses and all Songbooks Online rules and policies collectively constitute the agreement between you and the Providers. If you do not agree to these terms, you must discontinue use of the service. You must accept and abide by these terms as presented to you. Changes, additions or deletions are not acceptable, and Providers may refuse access to the Songbooks Online service for your non-compliance with any part of this agreement.

By continuing to use the service you confirm that: You are 18 years of age or older.

You have read and understood the present agreement in full. You agree with all the clauses of the present agreement.

Definition of Songbooks Online service

Providers, are the providers of the Songbooks Online service (the 'Service') that permits Smart device users to download and install specially designed apps that allow them to search and submit Karaoke song requests directly to the Karaoke host from the convenience of their Smart device

Age requirements for use of the Service

This Service is available for individuals aged 18 years or older.

System Requirements

Use of the Service requires a compatible device, Internet access (fees may apply), and certain software (fees may apply), and may require obtaining updates or upgrades from time to time. Because use of the Service involves hardware, software, and Internet access, your ability to use the Service may be affected by the performance of these factors.

High-speed Internet access is strongly recommended.

You acknowledge and agree that such system requirements, which may be changed from time to time, are your responsibility. The Service is not part of any other product or offering, and no purchase or obtaining of any other product shall be construed to represent or guarantee you access to the Service.

Your Information

You agree to provide accurate, current, and complete information required to register with the Service and at other points as may be required in the course of using the Service ("Registration Data"). You further agree to maintain and update your Registration Data as required to keep it accurate, current, and complete. Providers may terminate your rights to any or all of the Service if any information you provide is false, inaccurate or incomplete. You agree that Providers may store and use the Registration Data you provide for use in maintaining your account and balance.

User Account and Security

Account and Password. As a registered user of the Service, you may establish an account ('Account'). You are solely responsible for maintaining the confidentiality and security of your Account. You should not reveal your Account information to anyone else or use anyone else's Account. You are entirely responsible for all activities that occur on or through your Account, and you agree to immediately notify Providers of any unauthorized use of your Account or any other breach of security. Security. You agree not to violate or attempt to violate any security components of the Service. Service Payment

Providers provide chargeable Services. You pay for the Service before the Service is provided (prepayment) according to rules and rates. The base cost to you for Songbooks Online service is \$14.98 per month or \$99.98 per year plus taxes as applicable depending on the selected subscription plan, charged to the Payment Method you have provided. All fees and charges are non-refundable. From time to time, Providers and/or their business partners may extend special rates and/or promotions that can change the base price for the Service.

Because the Songbooks Online Service is offered in multiple time zones, for consistency, a "day" for purposes of these Terms of Use begins at 12:00 a.m. Eastern Time and ends at 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time of that same calendar day.

By signing up for your Songbooks Online subscription, you are expressly agreeing that we are authorized to charge you a monthly or annual subscription fee, any other fees for additional services you may purchase, and any applicable taxes in connection with your use of Songbooks Online to the credit card or other payment method accepted by Providers ("Payment Method") that you provided during registration. If your Payment Method expires and you do not update your Payment Method information or cancel your account, you authorize us to continue billing, and you will remain responsible for any uncollected amounts.

As used in these Terms of Use, "billing" shall indicate either a charge or debit, as applicable, against your Payment Method. The subscription fee will be billed at the beginning of your subscription or expiration of your free trial period, if any, whichever is earlier, and on each monthly or annual renewal thereafter unless and until you cancel your subscription or the account or service is otherwise suspended or discontinued pursuant to these Terms.

We automatically bill your Payment Method monthly or annually on the monthly or annual expiration date. However, if you change your Payment Method, this could result in changing the day upon which you are billed. In the event your subscription began on a day not contained in a given month, we bill your Payment Method on the last day of such month. For example, if you became a paying subscriber on January 31, your Payment Method would next be billed on February 28. You acknowledge that the amount billed each month may vary due to promotional offers, changes in your subscription plan, and changes in applicable taxes, and you authorize us to charge your Payment Method for the corresponding amounts. Refunds

All sales are final. No refunds are provided whatsoever. In the case of cancellation or suspension of your account refunds will not be applicable. In the event that you cancel your subscription, no refund will be given for the unused portion of the current subscription.

Right to Change Prices and Availability of Products. Provider has the right to change prices and availability of any Products at any time.

Electronic Signatures and Contracts. Your use of the Service includes the ability to enter into agreements and/or to make purchases electronically. You acknowledge that your electronic submissions constitute your agreement and intent to be bound by and to pay for such agreements and purchases. Account Termination.

Account termination by Providers.

If you fail, or Providers suspect that you have failed, to comply with any of the provisions of this Agreement, including but not limited to failure to make payment of fees due, failure to provide Providers with a valid credit card (or other invalid information in relation to payment for services) or with accurate and complete Registration Data, failure to safeguard your Account information, or violation of the Usage Rules or any license to the software, Providers, at their sole discretion, without notice to you may:

Terminate this Agreement and/or your Account, and you will remain liable for all amounts due under your Account up to and including the date of termination; and/or Terminate the license to the software; and/or Preclude access to the Service (or any part thereof)

Termination of the Service

Providers reserve the right to modify, suspend, or discontinue the Service (or any part or content thereof) at any time with or without notice to you, and Providers will not be liable to you or to any third party should it exercise such rights.

General Compliance with Laws

You also may be subject to additional terms and conditions that may apply when you use affiliate services, third-party content, or third-party software. If any part of these Terms of Service is held invalid or unenforceable, that portion shall be construed in a manner consistent with applicable law to reflect, as nearly as possible, the original intentions of the parties, and the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect. Provider's failure to enforce any right or provisions in these Terms of Service will not constitute a waiver of such provision, or any other provision of these Terms of Service. Cancellation

Right to Terminate
